Clarendon Street - Improvement Scheme
Road works

Dear Sir/Madam,

Following a public consultation process the above scheme received Part 8 planning approval. The Roads Design and Construction Division of Dublin City Council would like to inform you that it has engaged a Contractor, Actavo (Ireland) Ltd., to carry out the Clarendon Street Improvements Scheme.

Works will involve utility works (mainly water main replacements, drainage and public lighting) followed by repaving of footways and surfacing of the carriageway. The scheme extends from the junction of Chatham Street to the junction with Wicklow Street.

Works are due to commence at the Chatham Street end of the scheme **on Tuesday the 4th of June, 2019.**

Traffic Management – Vehicular and Pedestrian access will be maintained during the first phases. Road Closure will be required in early 2020. Advance notification will be given regarding any closure. Work on the Scheme will cease through Operation Open City (16th of November to 6th of January)

The Scheme will last for a duration of approximately 12 months.

Dublin City Council and our Contractor, Actavo (Ireland) Ltd., apologise in advance for any inconvenience which may be caused during the course of these works, and every effort will be made to minimise disruption.
